# IDENTIFYING INFORMATION



- **Legal status:** Association.
- **Date of incorporation:** 10 November 2008.
- **Registered in the National Register of Associations** since 2009, Code 592584.
- **Objectives of the organisation:**
  - To provide social, legal and healthcare support to migrants experiencing difficulties with social integration (including the most vulnerable groups such as women and minors) in transit and destination countries.
  - To work in defence of human rights.
  - To carry out development cooperation activities in transit and origin countries of migrants.
  - To provide social, legal and healthcare support to refugees and asylum seekers in transit and/or destination countries.

## VISION

We believe in a world where the right to freedom of movement is respected. A world in which the human rights of people on the move are guaranteed. A world where borders do not exist.

## MISSION

We promote access to rights and the protection of life in border spaces, working in coordination with migrant communities in the pursuit of justice, truth and redress for victims of border violence and their families.

## VALUES

We work from a transnational, transcultural, anti-racist and feminist perspective, through which we denounce borders as spaces of impunity. The values that drive the day-to-day work of the collective are resistance, love, courage, rapid response, commitment, flexibility, community work and alliance with migrant community networks.

# THEMATIC AREAS



## #RIGHTOLIFE

365 days a year, we monitor the risk situations faced by people crossing the Western Euro-African Border. We coordinate with national rescue services, document violations of the right to life, and build a narrative of memory, truth, redress, justice and non-recurrence.

## #PAINTINTOJUSTICE

We support and accompany people on the move and their families in processes of restitution and redress following rights violations during migratory processes (disappearances and deaths at sea, family separations, illegal pushbacks and other forms of torture), carrying out transnational and transcultural mediation work with communities.

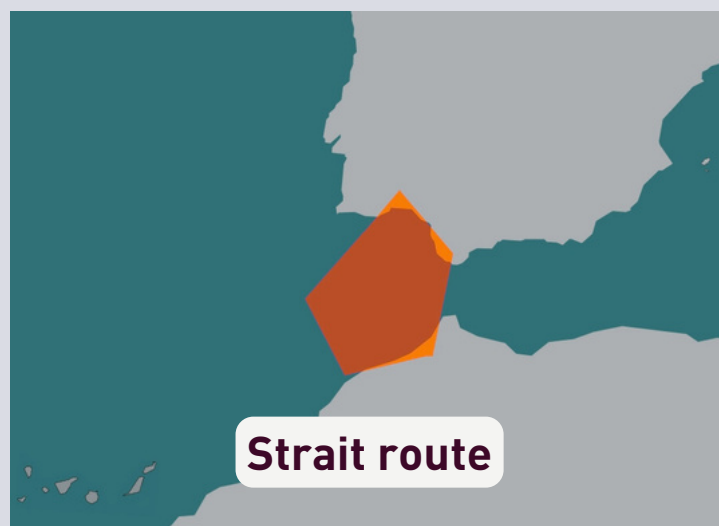
These areas of work are interconnected and serve to feed into the Human Rights Observatory, where, through communication and applied social research, we work in defence of the rights of people on the move.

# GEOGRAPHICAL AREA

For more than 20 years, we have been working to defend people and communities on the move at the Western Euro-African Border — encompassing the land and sea areas between the Spanish State, on one side, and the African coastal strip from the south of Senegal to the province of Jijel, in Algeria.

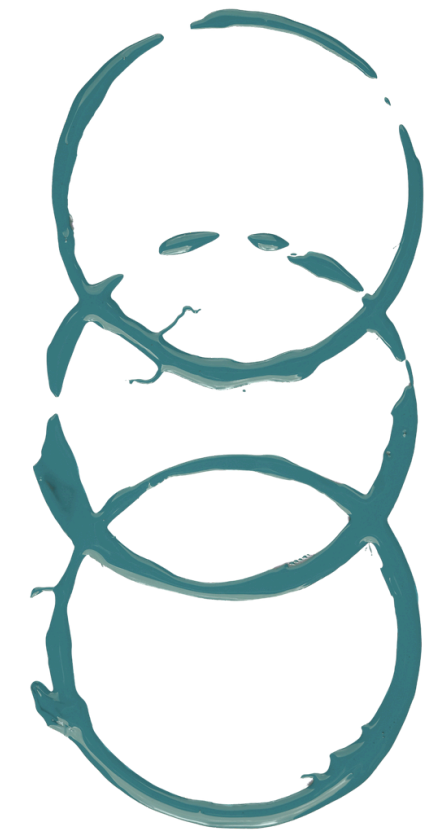
In the coming years, we expect to continue working at this border and denouncing and making visible the violations committed on the following migratory routes:

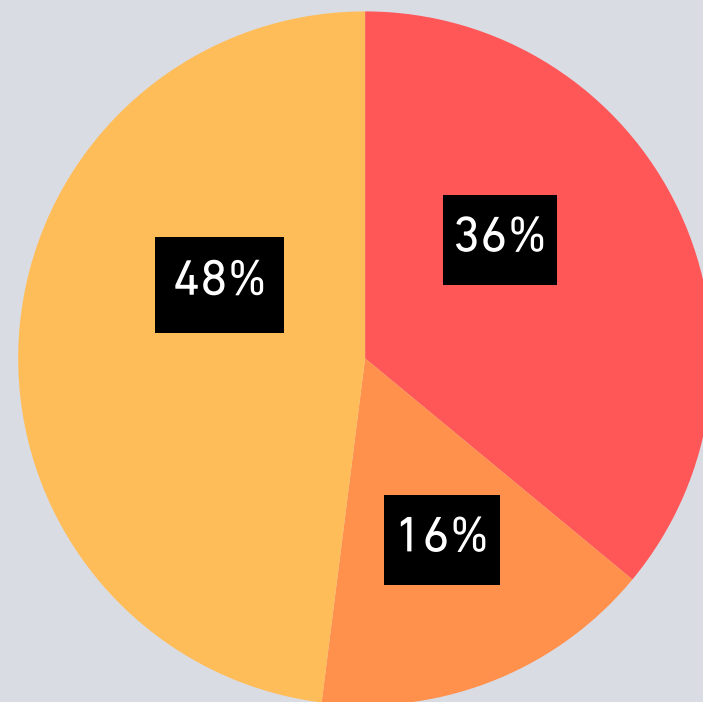

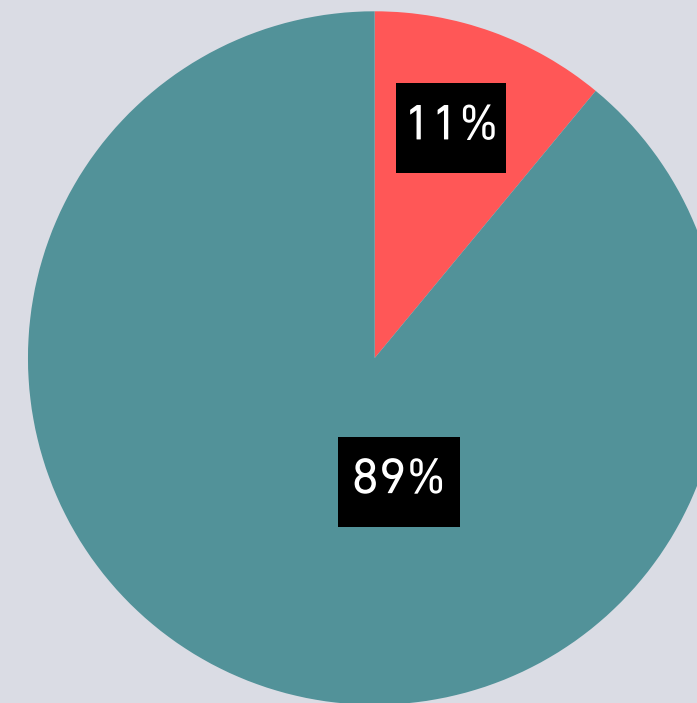


## INCOME 2025

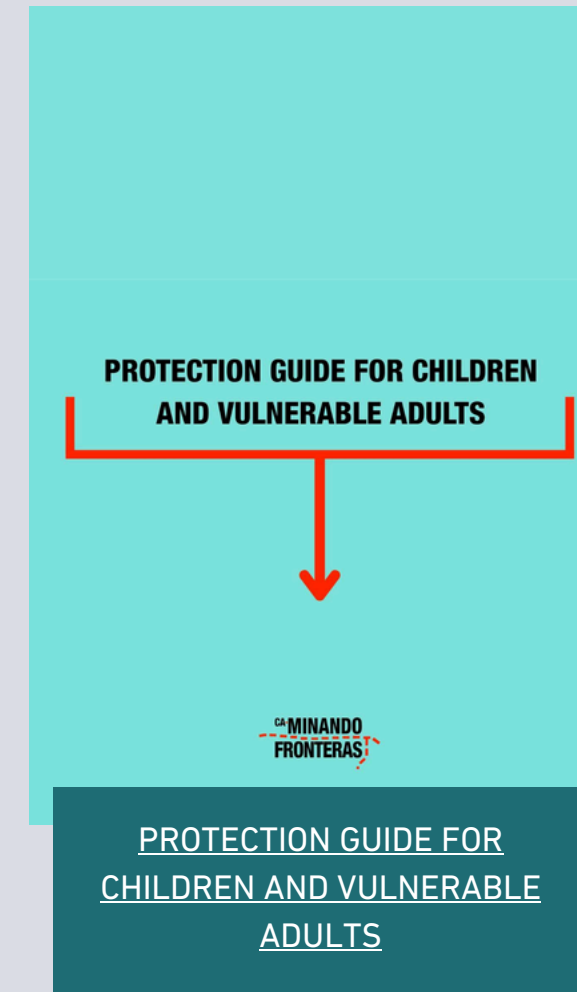
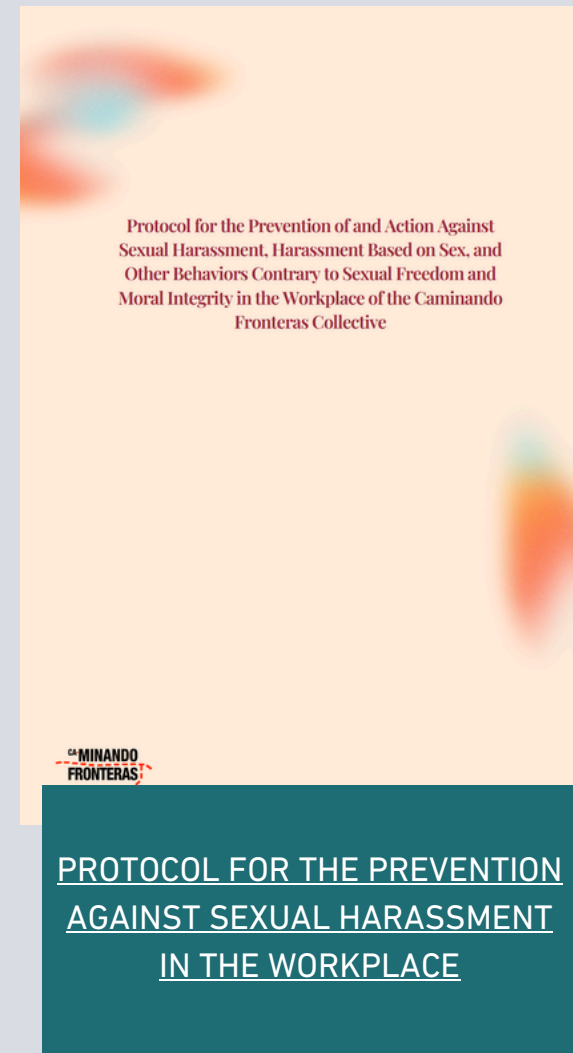
